- (1) The right of access to the relevant information regarding the processing of his/her data;
- (2) The right to rectification and erasure of his/her data;
- (3) The right to restriction of processing regarding his/her data;
- (4) The right to data portability;
- (5) The right to object to processing his/her data; and
- (6) The rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling
